#### GRANTS UPDATE



The Grants Team might seem quiet in the summer, but as soon as we hand out checks in April, we're laying the groundwork for the year ahead. Here's what you can look forward to this fall.

First, we've been busy lining up our 2024 Grants Team. We have a full slate of Grant Review Committee (GRC) Co-Leaders, some new, some veterans, and all excited about the new grantmaking season. Already on the job is **Leslie Blankenship**, who has stepped in as Grants Oversight Assistant Chair. Leslie is shadowing Co-Chairs **Kathy Bloch** and **Dana Simpson-Stokes** to learn more about their roles and responsibilities.

You might recall that, based on recommendations from an independent ad hoc committee, for 2023 we opted to continue offering multiple Impetus Grants of up to \$25,000 for the foreseeable future. Per committee findings, we also invested in a new grant-management software system that has received rave reviews from nonprofits and volunteers alike and set us up to succeed well into the future.

In preparation for our 15th anniversary year, we've pursued more of the study's recommendations. A strategy group comprising Kathy, Dana, Leslie, **Marney**Malik, Debby Kweller, and Dian Duvall, assisted by Barbara Talbott and representatives of the Catalyst Fund, developed and proposed a special new grant initiative that was approved by the Impact100 Sonoma Board in July. We'll make the big announcement at the Annual Garden Party on September 23—yet another reason to attend!

Now is also the time to consider serving on a 2024 GRC or the Financial Review Committee (FRC), from January through April. **Signups begin right after the Garden Party and close December 1.** Watch for your invitation letter and learn more **HERE**.



#### CO-PRESIDENTS CORNER

September conjures many happy images—back-to-school routines, the return of football season, and, here in wine country, the grape harvest. This month also marks the kickoff of our 2024 grants season and annual membership drive, when we encourage members to renew and to recruit more women to join our giving circle.

We'll make it all official at our Annual Garden Party on Saturday afternoon, September 23. In a few weeks we'll gather in the extraordinary home gardens of Impact100 members **Penney Magrane** and **Joan Howley, MD**. (More details appear below.) This membership campaign is even more special because we'll also celebrate our 15th anniversary in 2024 by showcasing our accomplishments, recognizing our nonprofit and community partners, and thanking you, our member donors.

As you consider renewing your membership or recruiting friends, we want to remind you that the annual minimum donation for 2024 is \$1,200. Of that amount, \$1,000 goes exclusively to fund grants, while the remaining \$200 goes to help cover essential operating expenses. Impact100 Sonoma is growing. Since our founding in 2009, our membership has tripled, and running our organization has become more technically complex. Operating expenses include basics such as insurance, post-office box and licensing fees, venue rentals, general administration, and a web-based enrollment and accounting system. More recently we have addressed the need for grant management software and bookkeeping assistance.

One such operating essential is **Jennifer Taylor**, our remote, part-time administrator, with us since 2019. Last month several board members had the opportunity to meet with her in person. We all benefit from her cheerful, professional assistance and can-do spirit. She is definitely a key resource as we head into our 2024 membership campaign and milestone year. Thank you, Jen, for your countless contributions.
